

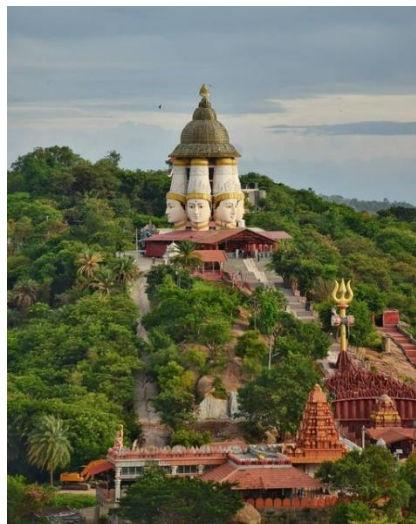
Places that can be Visited in and Around Bangalore

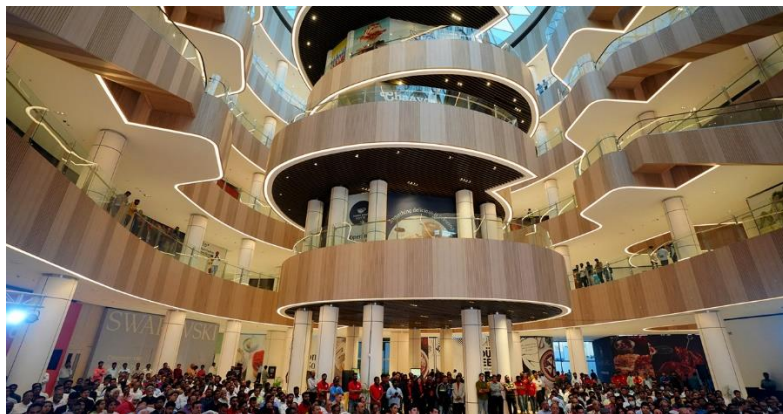
